

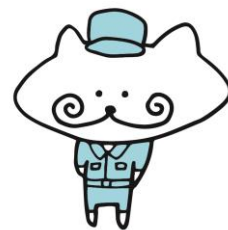

Help Reduce Recycle and Waste

Use designated garbage bags

The city requires designated garbage bags for **Burnable, Plastic, Non-Burnable, Dangerous/Harmful** and **Beverage can** waste.

✘ **Please use Non-burnable garbage bags for Dangerous/Harmful garbage.**

How to put out your garbage.

Separate all garbage properly and place it directly into the designated bags. Wrap items not wanted to be seen in newspaper if burnable, or use colored bags if non-burnable. However, if you cover the entire inside of the bag with an inner bag or paper, the contents will not be visible, so please keep the use of inner bags to a minimum.

Please put out your garbage by 8:30 am on collection day.

Garbage not in designated bags will not be collected.

Use the designated garbage station

Put garbage out at the designated station for your area. Ask your neighborhood association or landlord for the location. Stations are managed by local associations, apartments, or condos.

✘ **Do not throw garbage at stations in other districts.**

Please consider "Okura" before disposing of it.

~You may be able to avoid disposal costs and the hassle of removing it.~

"Okura" is an online service that allows you to compare purchase prices from multiple reuse shops and sell your items.

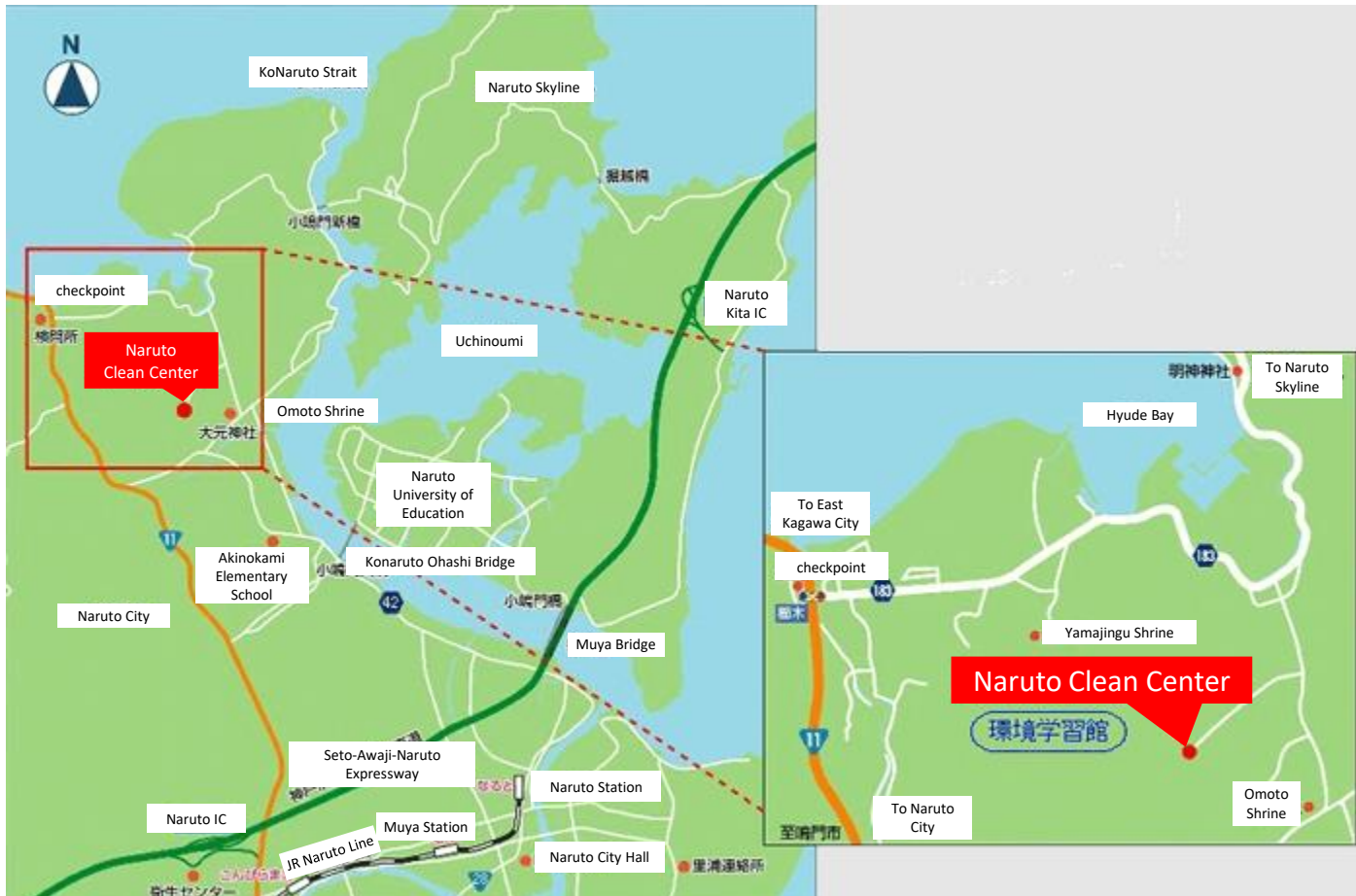

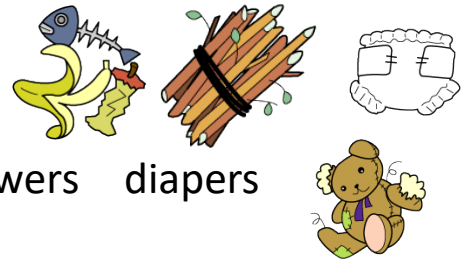
How to dispose of garbage in Naruto City

Rule 1: Dispose of garbage in **Naruto City marked garbage bags**.

Rule 2: Place garbage **in the designated place** on the correct collection day by **8:30 AM**.

Burnable garbage

Please put out by **8:30 AM** on the collection day.

Please use the designated garbage bags.

Anything that is 30cm or larger in length, width, or height is considered Bulky waste.

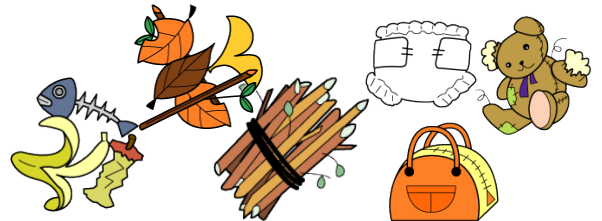
Main burnable garbage (Please refer to the garbage sorting chart for details.)

Food waste (Use a food waste disposal system whenever possible.)

Leaves and weeds (let the leaves dry)

Fabric products

Leather products



Precautions when disposing of garbage

Food waste (Drain thoroughly and place in designated garbage bags. (It can be wrapped newspaper or other materials.))

Disposable diapers (Please flush waste down the toilet before disposing of it.)

Skewers (please wrap in newspaper etc. before disposal.)

Oil (soak in newspaper etc. and then dispose of it.)

→ (oil) Wrap it in newspaper etc.

Garden trees (Cut trees to lengths of no more than 30cm (no more than 5cm wide per tree) and place them in designated garbage bags for disposal. Five or more bags are considered 'bulky garbage')

Please drain the water from kitchen waste.

An analysis of the “burnable garbage” collected by the city showed that about 50% of the contents of the garbage is water, especially in kitchen waste. When burnable garbage contains a lot of moisture, more fuel is needed during incineration, which increases carbon dioxide emissions and raises garbage disposal costs. Also, the heavier weight makes it harder to take out the trash, and the characteristic odor of kitchen waste becomes more noticeable.

Therefore, let’s try the following tips:

Vegetable peels and such tend to get wet easily if placed directly into the sink strainer. If you peel vegetables over a sheet of newspaper and then wrap the peels in the newspaper before disposing, they will stay drier.

If possible, drying them in the sun will further reduce the amount of garbage.

You can use a PET bottle.

You can use a CD.

There are also specialized tools.

Squeezing by hand is okay too!

Plastic packaging (The container and packaging the product came in)

Please put out by **8:30 AM** on the collection day.

Please use the designated garbage bags.

Anything that is 30cm or larger in length, width, or height is considered Bulky waste.

Most plastic packaging has this identification mark.

Please use it as a guide for sorting.

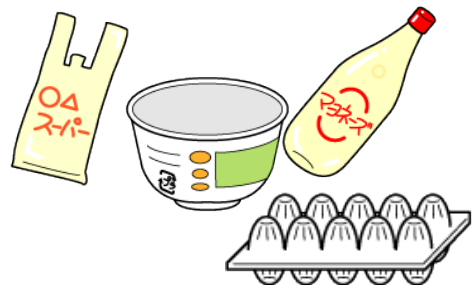

Precautions when disposing of garbage

Please remove the contents and rinse with water.(It's okay to cut it.)

Please remove any materials that are not plastic.

Please dispose of dirty items as burnable garbage.

Don't throw away dangerous objects or discarded medical equipment.

Not only because they are foreign substances, but for the safety of the waste sorting workers, you must absolutely not throw out dangerous objects or discarded medical equipment such as razors, lighters, and syringes. Please wrap razors in paper or cloth, completely remove all the gas from lighters, and throw them out amongst "**Dangerous/Harmful garbage.**" Please have family doctor clinics take care of syringes and other discarded medical equipment.



Please cooperate with recycling.

Plastic containers and packaging are recycled to be used again as plastic products or as raw materials in the chemical industry and iron manufacturing. Because every garbage bag is opened and sorted, please do not throw out double bagged garbage.

You must absolutely not throw out double or triple bagged garbage.

Double bagging means to put a smaller plastic bag full of garbage into the main garbage bag.

Put plastic containers and packaging that can't be fully cleaned into "Burnable Garbage."

Dangerous/Harmful garbage

Please put out by **8:30 AM** on the collection day.

Dangerous/Harmful garbage is collected on **Wednesdays**.

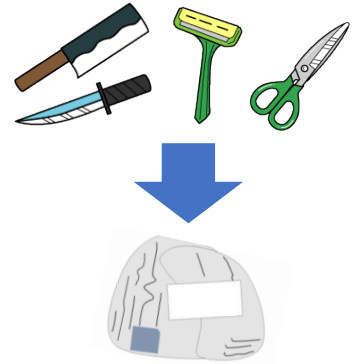

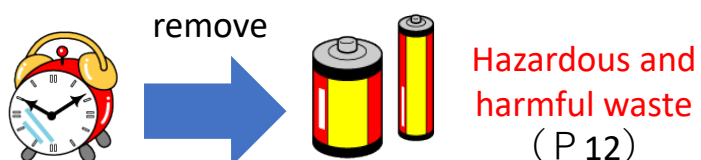

※Electric toothbrushes, disposable toothbrushes, natural bristles (such as boar bristles and soft bristles), and interdental brushes are not included.

※Once collected, the waste is reborn as new plastic products such as flower pots.

Please put out by **8:30 AM** on the collection day.

Please use the designated garbage bags.

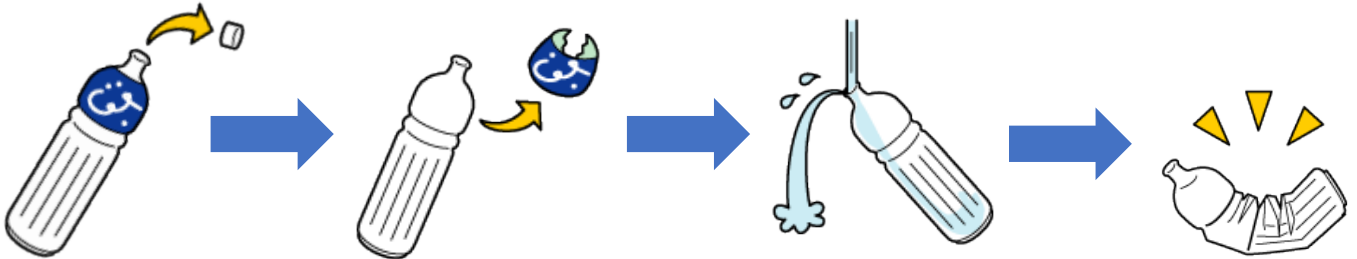

How to Dispose of PET Bottles




- ① Be sure to remove the label and cap
- ② Rinse lightly to remove any dirt from inside the bottle.
- ③ Flatten the bottle. Take it to a recycling station.



Please Note!! **The label/cap and the PET bottle itself are disposed of differently.**

Please dispose of the removed label and cap with Plastic packaging.

Others things to keep in mind when disposing of garbage

Some bottles for shampoo, laundry detergent, dishwashing detergent, cooking oil, seasonings, lactic acid bacteria drinks, etc. are **not made of PET**. Please check for the plastic mark  on these bottles and dispose of them in the designated garbage bag as **“Plastic packaging.”**

Recyclable waste (Group Collection)

Please separate recyclable waste such as paper, cans, and old cloth and put them out according to the group collection in your neighborhood association, senior club, women's group, etc.

The method of disposal varies depending on the collection organization, so please contact your local collection organization for details.

Paper Waste is recyclable

Paper waste that we usually throw away—such as copy paper (about 4g per sheet), envelopes (about 6g each), and tissue boxes (about 35g each)—can actually be recycled. Please use **local recycling groups or collection shops** to reduce waste and make effective use of resources.

Food and snack boxes, Calendars and Leaflets

Items That Should Be Disposed of as Burnable Garbage

Waterproof/laminated paper (lamine-coated paper, etc.), Photos, photo print paper, Sealed postcards, stickers, carbon paper, etc. Food packaging with plastic or wrap attached, Detergent, incense stick, and cigarette boxes, Carbon-copy receipts and invoices, Iron-on transfer paper, Foil from chewing gum or cigarettes

Precautions when disposing of garbage (Group Collection)

The method of disposal varies depending on the collection organization, so please contact your local collection organization for details.

Beverage can → Rinse lightly with water and separate aluminum cans from steel cans.

Paper Waste → Be sure to tie each grouping securely with string.

Recyclable waste (collected at stores such as supermarkets)

Please separate milk cartons and trays, which are recyclable resources, and dispose of them at the collection points set up at supermarkets and other locations.

Precautions when disposing of garbage (storefront collection)

milk cartons → Open, wash, and dry drink cartons before disposal.

Remove any dirt before disposal.

Trays → The color of the trays collected varies depending on the store. Please check before disposal.



Bulky Waste • Electrical appliances

In principle, Bulky waste is waste that is 30cm or larger in length, width, or height.

Bulky waste and electronics not covered by the Home Appliance Recycling Law should be brought directly to the Clean Center.

2nd Saturday of every month: 8:30 AM – 12:00 PM

Clean Center Processing Fees

Oversized Waste - 70 yen per 10 kg

Bicycle - 500 yen per item

Household Electronics (Small) - 500 yen per item

Household Electronics (Large) - 3,000 yen per item

Recycling Fees

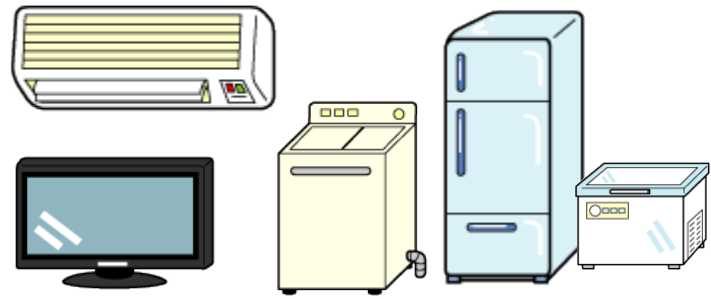
New household PCs sold at retail stores on or after October 1, 2003 include a collection and recycling fee. If the recycling fee is included at the time of sale, the PC will have a "PC Recycling Mark" attached to it, and there will be no additional charge when disposing of it. If you dispose of a PC without a PC Recycling Mark, you will need to pay the collection and recycling fee. The collection and recycling fee varies depending on the PC manufacturer and the PC 3R Promotion Center that performs the recycling, so please check with each collection office.

Note: Even for PCs with the PC Recycling Mark, if the manufacturer withdraws from business or goes bankrupt, the PC 3R Promotion Center will collect and recycle the PC when it is disposed of, so you will need to pay a new collection and recycling fee.

Home appliance recycling

Applicable Appliances

- Air Conditioner
- Refrigerator and freezer
- TV
- Washing machine and dryer

There are four ways to dispose of household appliances that are subject to recycling.

① **Have the store pick it up**

Please pay the “recycling fee” and “collection and transportation fee” to the store where you purchased the product or the store where you are replacing it with a new one. The “recycling fee” is the cost incurred by the manufacturer to recycle the product. The “collection and transportation fee” is the cost incurred by the store to collect the product and transport it to the manufacturer's designated collection site. This amount is set by each store.

② **Bring it directly to the collection site**

You can also bring the target products directly to the collection site without going through a store or clean center. In this case, please pay the “recycling fee” in advance at the post office and bring the documents you received to the collection point on page 24. You only need to pay the “recycling fee”. There are two collection points closest to the city on page 24. Please contact each collection point directly to find out the dates and times you can bring them.

③ Take it to the city clean center.

If the store where you purchased the eligible product has closed down or moved far away due to relocation, etc., you can bring the eligible product directly to the Clean Center. In this case, please pay the “recycling fee” at the post office, bring the documents you received to the Clean Center, and pay the “transportation fee” of 1,900 yen to the Clean Center.

④ Request a licensed general waste collection and transportation company

If you are unable to bring items directly to a clean center or collection site, you can also request a licensed contractor to collect them. Please request collection from the following contractors.

Illegal dumping is a crime

Dumping garbage in green areas is a crime.

Not only does it spoil the natural scenery, but it also harms the environment, causing issues such as sewage runoff. Strict penalties for this kind of illegal dumping are outlined in the Waste Management and Public Cleansing Act. These penalties apply not only to industrial waste, but also to general waste, including household garbage.

Those who engage in illegal dumping may face **up to 5 years of imprisonment or a fine of up to 10 million yen, or both.**

In the case of a corporation, the fine can be as high as 300 million yen.
